Her Majesty's royal licence and authority that he and his issue may take the name and bear the arms of Skeffington alone, in compliance with the direction to that effect contained in the will of his meternal Grandfather, the Right Honourable Chichester Skeffington Earl of Massereene, deceased; provided Her Majesty's royal concession and declaration be recorded in the Office of Ulster King of Arms of all Ireland, that the Officers of Arms there, and all others, upon occasion may take full notice, and have knowledge thereof. Which has been done accordingly.
