THE Queen has been pleased, by Warrant under the royal signet and sign manual, to give and grant to James Cooper Tuthill, of

Merrion-square, in the city of Dublin, Esquire,
Her Majesty's royal licence and authority, that
he and his issue may take and use the surname
of Cooper only, and bear the arms of Cooper,
in compliance with the conditions in the last
Will and Testament, and out of respect to the
memory of his relative, Honora, relict of James
Cooper, of Cooper Hill, in the county of Lime-
rick, Esquire, deceased; provided Her Majesty's
royal concession and declaration be recorded in
the Office of Ulster, King of Arms of all Ireland,
to the end that the Officers of Arms there, and
all others upon occasion, may take full notice
and have knowledge thereof; which has been
done accordingly.
