Her Majesty's royal licence and authority, that he and his issue may take and use the surname of Cope only, and quarter the arms of Cope with his own family arms, in compliance with the conditions in the last Will and Testament, and out of respect to the memory of his cousin, Arthur Cope, of Loughall aforesaid, Esq. deceased; provided Her Majesty's royal concession and declaration be recorded in the Office of Ulster, King of Arms in Ireland, to the end that the Officers of Arms there, and all others upon occasion, may take full notice and have knowledge thereof; which has been done accordingly.
