

Frequently Asked Questions

Who can apply?

The Law Reform Commission would like to hear from practicing solicitors or practicing barristers, academics, legal researchers, or anyone who can demonstrate expertise in one or more of the categories specified in the DPS. Applicants can be individuals, companies, or sole traders.

Do I have to be VAT registered?

No, you do not have to be VAT registered to apply for the DPS. Your PPS Number is sufficient to allow you to register as a supplier.

Do I require Professional Indemnity Insurance?

It is not a requirement of this tender that applicants must have professional indemnity insurance.

What level of expertise is required?

The Law Reform Commission would like to hear from applicants who have gained their experience through a variety of channels and not just through independent research, including through employment in legal research bodies, law firms, academic institutions, working as sole traders, as well as other relevant organisations.
